



## **Description:**

Tirem Kentucky bluegrass was developed by Pure-Seed Testing, Inc. Tirem was selected for its deep roots and exceptional performance in drought conditions. Tirem also maintains winter color remarkably well. Additionally this variety displays tolerance to salt and heat pressure. Tirem has good overall disease resistance. Specifically to dollar spot, rust, summer patch and red thread. Qualified by the Turfgrass Water Conservation Alliance for statistically significant water saving potential, this variety is a must have in your product portfolio.

## **Applications:**

Tirem mixes well and compliments perennial ryegrass and tall fescue. Tirem can handle low mowing .50" (1.25 cm.) and is a popular choice for golf course use. It is also ideal for low maintenance situations as it maintains great turf performance even with reduced fertilizer and watering. Tirem germinates and establishes rapidly which makes it ideal for use in sod, especially when blended with tall fescue.

## **Geographical Adaption:**

Tirem performs excellent throughout the typical cool season zones and well into the transition zone. It can be utilized as a component with perennial ryegrass to enhance the seasonal turf performance in the overseeding of bermudagrass in southern athletic fields. It can also be mixed with tall fescue for the Transition Zone. Seeding rates typically range between 2-3 lbs./1,000 sq. ft (97-146 kg/ha). Normal establishment is between 14-21 days under good growing conditions. Fertilize at 3 lbs N/1000sq.ft./year.
